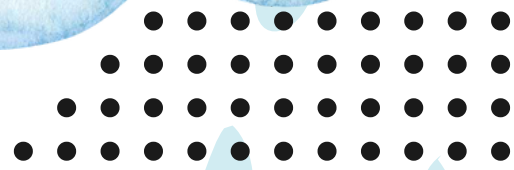

- 1) Deep breathing to reduce stress- deep slow breathing helps us to think and calm.

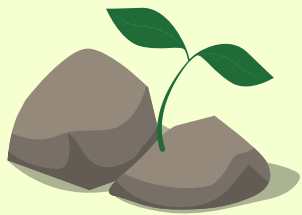

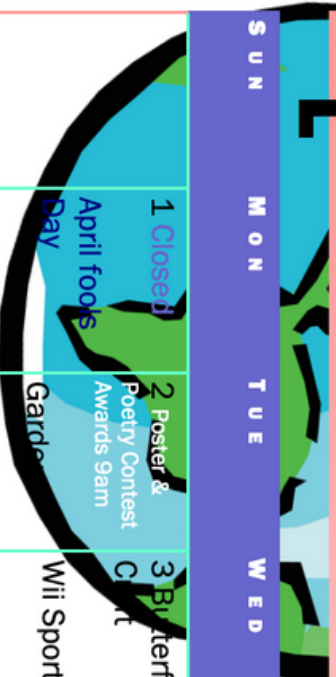

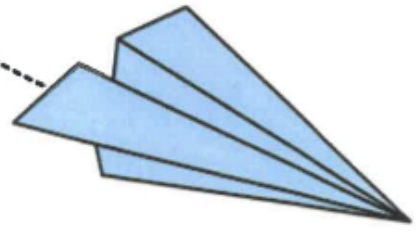

Come out to the Columbia Airport, Columbia, off Parrots Ferry Road, not far from the historic downtown area.

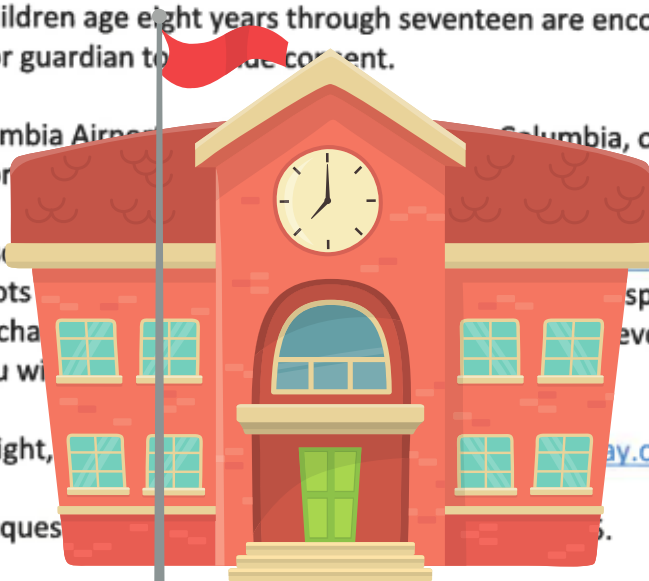
