




ELA

ELA ACHIEVEMENT



- CCSA 3rd grade average score for ELA CAASPP Assessment was 2425, 15 points higher than the state average.
- average scores for fifth grade students was 55 points higher than the state average
- Average score for 6th grade students was exactly the same as the state average.
- 4th grade students demonstrated a reduction in standard met scores.
- Over-all achievement in ELA at CCSA decreased between 2023 and 2024 annual testing dates. This can be attributed to the 25% change in student body.

MATHEMATICS ACHIEVEMENT



- CCSA percentage of students who met or exceeded the standard in math remains higher than the average for the state of California.
- Students in grades 3, 4, 5, & 6 remained within 40 points of the state average across grades for math achievement.
- 77% of 3rd graders met or exceeded standard in mathematics.

ATTENDANCE & BEHAVIOR



- In the 2023-2024 school year, Chinese Camp Science Academy maintained a rate of 6.3% chronic Absenteeism. This demonstrated an improvement of 6.3% over the previous school year.
- The Chronic Absenteeism rate of CCSA significantly exceeded the state average of 24.3%.
- In the 2023-2024 school year, 6.2% of students from the Chinese Camp Science Academy were suspended on at least one occasion. This is an increase from the previous school year.

FAMILY ENGAGEMENT & ENRICHMENT



- CCSA family events, including the Winter Sing, and spring Open House, were heavily attended, with nearly 90% of families in attendance at both events.
- CCSA maintained their schedule of monthly field trips to perform community service for elderly members of the Tuolumne County Community.
- CCSA participated in more than five fieldtrips with specific emphasis on engagement and experiential education related to science topics and aligned with NGSS Standards.
- All students at CCSA continued to receive enrichment education through weekly art and music classes.
