

JAMESTOWN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL Single Plan for Student Achievement 2024-2025

ELA ACHIEVEMENT

- Between 2023-2024, JES students increased in ELA proficiency from 22.11% of students meeting or exceeding standard to 26.49% of students meeting or exceeding standard.
- In 2024, JSD 3rd graders met or exceeded standard at a rate of 47%. This was higher than the state average of 42%.
- Although overall achievement is below the state average, JES is improving at a rate that is significantly higher than the state average for year over year growth.
- Nearly all grade levels met or exceeded the 2023-2024 achievement goals set in the Single Plan for Student Achievement.



MATH ACHIEVEMENT

- The 3rd graders in 2024 exceeded the goal for initial test data. 52% of these students met or exceeded standard in Math. This is higher than the state average for third grade.
- Nearly all grade levels achieved a high level of proficiency than the year prior.
- Over-all math data showed an increase from 20.19% of students meeting or exceeding standard to 23.74% of studnets meeting or exceeding the standard in
- Though we are still performing at a lower average than the state of California as a whole, JES rate of improvement is higher than the growth rate of the state.



ATTENDANCE & BEHAVIOR

- Chronic Absenteeism decreased from 30.8% to 24.2%. This is an improvement of 6.6%.
- Suspension rates for students increased from 7.5% of students being suspended to 8.7% of students being suspended. This was an increase of 1.2% in rate of suspensions.



FAMILY ENGAGEMENT & ENRICHMENT

- Family participation in Family Fun Nights averaged 175 attendees or more over the course of the 2023-2024 school year.
- 14.7% of families retured the annual parent survey. This nearly achieved our
- goal of 15% family participation. JSD continuted to offer enrichment education, including art class for all students, music opportunities for all students, and optional enrollment in the

All students will continue to have access to a broad course of study through the offerings of art, music, technology, student leadership, health, and world language.

Expecteted Outcomes: ELA

- Studnets in grade 3 will perform at a mean scaled score of 2420 or higher.
- All students in grades 4-8 will demonstrate growth on ELA CAASPP of 5% from the previous year's data.

Expected Outcomes: Attendance

Chronic Abenteeism will reduce to 15% or less by the end of the 2024-2025 School

Expected Outcome: Art Education

All studnets will continue to have access to visual and performing arts education through Music and Art classes.

Expected Outcomes: Math

- Students in grade 3 will perform at a mean scaled score of 2450 or higher
- All studnets in grades 4-8 will demonstrate individual growth on Math CAASPP of 5% from the previous year's data.

Expected Outcomes: Suspensions

The school will have a total of 35 suspensions or fewer at the end of the school year. The total percentage of suspensions will affect 5% of the students or less.

Expected Outcome: Spanish Language Instruction

Student performcance on the California Spanish Assessment will increase by an average of 5 points per grade level.

Expected Outcomes: K-2

- K Dibels Data will reflect Letter Naming Fluency of 90% or higher for all studnets.
- 85% of 1-2 grade students will meet oral reading fluency benchmark by the end of the school year.
- 90% of Kindergarten students will demonstrate proficiency in counting to 100 at a rate of 80% or higher.
- Students in grade 1 will demonstrate 80% proficiency in their ability to add within 100. Students in grade 2 will add and subtract within 100

Expected Outcome: Family Engagement School will host at least

- three family fun nights.
- Family fun night attendanc will be at least 150 people.
- 50 families will return the Annual Parent Survey.

Expected Outcome: Visual and Performing Arts **Performances**

Jamestown Elementary School will present the community with at least three concert events, and one performing arts event that includes theater.
