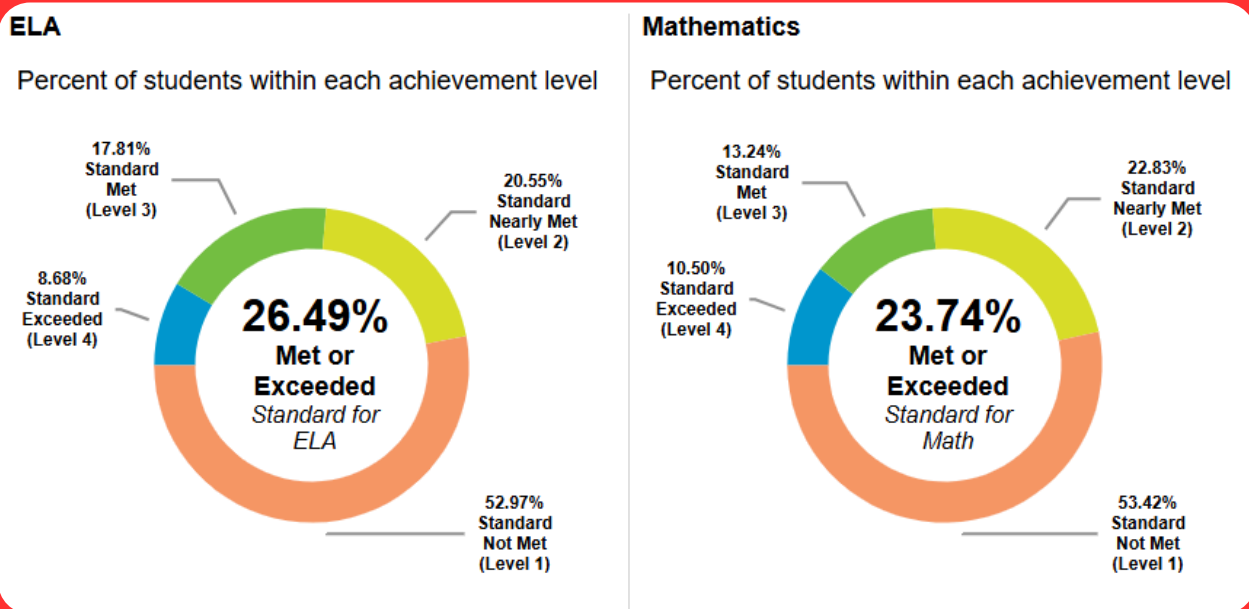

ELA ACHIEVEMENT



- Between 2023-2024, JES students increased in ELA proficiency from 22.11% of students meeting or exceeding standard to 26.49% of students meeting or exceeding standard.
- In 2024, JSD 3rd graders met or exceeded standard at a rate of 47%. This was higher than the state average of 42%.
- Although overall achievement is below the state average, JES is improving at a rate that is significantly higher than the state average for year over year growth.
- Nearly all grade levels met or exceeded the 2023-2024 achievement goals set in the Single Plan for Student Achievement.

MATH ACHIEVEMENT



- The 3rd graders in 2024 exceeded the goal for initial test data. 52% of these students met or exceeded standard in Math. This is higher than the state average for third grade.
- Nearly all grade levels achieved a high level of proficiency than the year prior.
- Over-all math data showed an increase from 20.19% of students meeting or exceeding standard to 23.74% of students meeting or exceeding the standard in math.
- Though we are still performing at a lower average than the state of California as a whole, JES rate of improvement is higher than the growth rate of the state.

ATTENDANCE & BEHAVIOR



- Chronic Absenteeism decreased from 30.8% to 24.2%. This is an improvement of 6.6%.
- Suspension rates for students increased from 7.5% of students being suspended to 8.7% of students being suspended. This was an increase of 1.2% in rate of suspensions.

FAMILY ENGAGEMENT & ENRICHMENT



- Family participation in Family Fun Nights averaged 175 attendees or more over the course of the 2023-2024 school year.
- 14.7% of families returned the annual parent survey. This nearly achieved our goal of 15% family participation.
- JSD continued to offer enrichment education, including art class for all students, music opportunities for all students, and optional enrollment in the Dual Immersion Spanish program.
